

VA Disability Pay Chart for TDIU

Dependent Status (no children)	Monthly TDIU Pay:
Veteran alone	\$3,332.06
With spouse	\$3,517.84
With spouse and 1 parent	\$3,666.94
Spouse and 2 parents	\$3,816.04
With 1 parent	\$3,481.16
With 2 parents	\$3,630.26

Total disability based on individual unemployability (TDIU) is a type of VA disability rating that pays at the same monthly rate as 100%. It is granted to veterans with conditions that don't add up to 100% but are severe enough that they are unable to work.

How does a veteran qualify for TDIU?

- You must have at least one service-connected disability rated at least at 60%, OR two or more service-connected disabilities with at least one disability ratable at 40% or more with a combined rating of 70% or more.
- You must be unable to maintain substantially gainful employment as a result of service-connected disabilities (marginal employment, such as odd jobs, is not considered substantial gainful employment for VA purposes).
- You must not have been discharged dishonorably.
